

Ambassador Camino was born in Lima on September 29, 1961. He studied Philosophy and History at the Faculty of Pontifical and Civil Theology of Lima and at the Pontifical Catholic University of Peru. He also studied at the Diplomatic Academy of Peru "Javier Pérez de Cuéllar", where he obtained his degree in International Relations, in addition to the title of Career Diplomat. He holds a master's degrees in "Regional Integration" and "International Law and International Relations" from the Ortega y Gasset University Research Institute, of the Complutense University of Madrid.

Before taking office as Vice Minister of Foreign Affairs, he served as Director-General of the Americas at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Previously, at the headquarters of the Foreign Ministry, he held the positions of Director of South America, Director of Drug Control, as well as worked in various roles in the Ministerial Cabinet, in the General Directorate of Asia, the Pacific Rim, Africa, and the Middle East, in the General Directorate of America, and in the General Directorate of Protocol.

He became Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary Ambassador of Peru in the Argentine Republic, where he previously served as Consul General of Peru in La Plata. He also served in the Embassy of Peru in the Kingdom of Spain, in the Permanent Representation of Peru to the Organization of American States, in the Embassy of Peru in Austria, and in the Consulate General of Peru in Washington DC.

He has been awarded by the Republic of Peru with the Order of "Merit of the Diplomatic Service of Peru José Gregorio Paz Soldán" in the Grade of Grand Cross; by the Federative Republic of Brazil with the Order of Rio Branco in the Grade of Grand Cross; by the Republic of Chile with the Order of Bernardo O'Higgins in the Grade of Grand Officer and with the Order of Merit in the Grade of Officer; by the Kingdom of Spain with the Order of Civil Merit in the Grade of Encomienda and with the Order of Civil Merit in the Grade of Encomienda de Numero; and by the Republic of Austria with the Goldene Ehrenzeichen Order.
